We advise using text size from **12 to 22** to best support students so they can improve their reading and literacy skills.





Handwriting Style	Bradley hand Diary of a Wimpy Kid handwritten style
Calligraphic Style	Calligraphy can be particularly difficult to read if you are dyslexic.
